

JURY FINDS ZOLTEK GUILTY OF BREACH OF CONTRACT

Gurit (SWX: GUR) subsidiary Structural Polymer Group Ltd. has won its lawsuit against Zoltek Corporation (NASDAQ: ZOLT) for breach of an exclusive requirements contract and for monetary damages.

Wattwil/Switzerland, ST. LOUIS/USA, November 30, 2006. Under a 10-year contract between Gurit subsidiary Structural Polymer Group Ltd. and Zoltek Corporation entered into in 2000, Zoltek promised to supply Structural Polymer Group and its affiliate SP Systems – now known as Gurit (UK) – with large filament count carbon fibres. In the lawsuit, Gurit noted Zoltek's repeated failure to meet SP Group's requirements.

The lawsuit was filed in February 2005. The jury trial, before the Hon. Carol Jackson in Federal Court in the Eastern District of Missouri, lasted nearly three and a half weeks. The verdict was rendered on November 29th 2006 finding that Zoltek breached the contract and awarding Gurit damages of over \$36 million. Gurit has requested that Zoltek be ordered to specifically perform the contract for the rest of its term.
