

Court decrees that Zoltek's supply contract remains in effect

- Federal Court honours Gurit's sourcing contract with Zoltek
- Gurit orders nearly 1600 tons of Zoltek carbon fibre for 2007

The Federal Court in the Eastern District of Missouri entered judgement against Zoltek Corporation (NASDAQ: ZOLT) in full amount of the jury's verdict following a successful lawsuit of Gurit (SWX: GUR) subsidiary Structural Polymer Group Ltd. to enforce a 10 year contract for large filament count carbon fibre supplies.

Wattwil/Switzerland, St. Louis/USA, December 14, 2006. Following a successful lawsuit by Gurit Subsidiary Structural Polymer Group Ltd. to enforce an exclusive 10-year sourcing contract for large filament count carbon fibres, the Federal Court in the Eastern District of Missouri/USA has entered judgement against Zoltek Corporation in full amount of the jury's verdict.

The Jury awarded Gurit damages over USD 36 million and Court judgement was now entered accordingly. In addition, the Court decreed that the contract, which requires Zoltek to supply Gurit with carbon fibres in annually increasing volumes, is to remain in effect until December 31, 2010.

Acting on this entitlement, Gurit has placed orders with Zoltek for nearly 1600 tons of carbon fibres for delivery in 2007.
